Professional Licensure Disclosure Statement: Nova Southeastern University, H. Wayne Huizenga College of Business and Entrepreneurship, Master of Accounting Program meets the educational degree completion requirement for licensure in all 50 states as well as five additional jurisdictions. Graduates of a Master of Accounting Program offered through an accredited institution such as Nova Southeastern University are eligible to sit for the Certified Public Accountancy Examination in any U.S. State, its territories, the District of Columbia, and Puerto Rico. Students should note that requirements for professional licensure can vary drastically by state. Because these requirements can change frequently and often without notice, it is strongly encouraged and is the responsibility of the student to ensure the degree they earn will meet requirements for licensure in the state in which they seek to be licensed. The H. Wayne Huizenga College of Business and Entrepreneurship cannot confirm whether its Master of Accounting degree meets all of the licensure requirements in a student’s state of residence.
