Kenneth J. (Ken) Kies is Managing Director of the Federal Policy Group, a practice of Clark Consulting, Inc. Mr. Kies has delivered significant legislative and regulatory results for his clients, which include major corporations, trade associations, and coalitions of companies with common objectives. Among Washington “lobbying” firms, the Federal Policy Group has grown to sixth largest in terms of revenues. Prior to the acquisition of the Federal Policy Group by Clark Consulting in February 2002, Mr. Kies was Co-Managing Partner of the Washington National Tax Services office of PricewaterhouseCoopers LLP and prior to that position, he served as the Chief of Staff of the Congressional Joint Committee on Taxation from January 1995 until January 1998. The position of Chief of Staff of the Joint Committee on Taxation was created by the Revenue Act of 1926. Mr. Kies was the 10th person to serve in this position. Mr. Kies was one of four private sector participants to co-moderate President Clinton’s White House Conference on Social Security in 1998.

As a leading expert on tax policy issues, Mr. Kies frequently appears on radio and television, including National Public Radio, MSNBC, ABC, CNN, Fox News and regularly is quoted in print news publications such as the Wall Street Journal, the Washington Post, The New York Times, Newsweek, and Time. He has delivered over 1,000 speeches in countries such as Puerto Rico, Canada, Austria, the Czech Republic, Sweden, Spain, France, Scotland, England, Ireland, Portugal, Bermuda and Barbados since 1981.

Mr. Kies holds an L.L.M., Taxation from Georgetown University Law School, 1986, a JD, Cum Laude from the Ohio State University College of Law, 1977, and a B.G.S. (University College), Cum Laude, from Ohio University, 1974.
