6. Untaxed portions of IRA distributions from IRS Form 1040-lines (15a minus 15b) or 1040A –lines (11a minus 11b). **Exclude rollovers.** If negative, enter a zero.
7. Untaxed portions of pensions from IRS Form 1040 – lines (16a minus 16b) or 1040A – lines (12a minus 12b) **Exclude rollovers.** If negative, enter a zero.
8. Credit for federal tax on special fuels from IRS Form 4136 – line 15 – nonfarmers only.
9. Housing, food, and other living allowances paid to members of the military, clergy, and others (including cash payments and cash value of benefits).
10. Veterans' noneducation benefits such as Disability, Death Pension, or Dependency & Indemnity Compensation (DIC) and/or VA Educational Work-Study allowances.
11. Any other untaxed income or benefits not reported elsewhere on Worksheets A and B, such as worker's compensation, untaxed portions of railroad retirement benefits, Black Lung Benefits, disability etc. **Don't include:** student aid, Workforce Investment Act educational benefits, or benefits from flexible-spending arrangements, e.g., cafeteria plans.
