

Bachelor of Science in Vision Science

The College of Optometry awards a Bachelor of Science in Vision Science degree to those who do not possess a baccalaureate degree and who complete 90 credit hours of undergraduate work, plus two years of optometric study at NSU. These students do not attend the commencement ceremonies or Senior Awards Dinner Dance, since they will do so upon completion of their final two years of optometric study. It is a requirement, however, that students eligible to receive the Bachelor of Science in Vision Science degree fill in the online Application for Degree/Diploma during the second semester of their second year of study within the College of Optometry. The last step in the process to apply for your degree is to remit payment. Once you have completed the information on the Application for Degree/Diploma form and press Submit, you will be given a link to go to for payment. The fee associated with your degree program is \$ 75.00.

You will receive a letter from the conferral department staff informing you about when to expect to receive your diploma. Diplomas are mailed priority mail for delivery within three to four business days. This does not account for holidays or out-of-country.
