### **HOMELAND SECURITY PROTECTION PROGRAM**

*Vigilance: Patrolling in the New Era of Terrorism* is the theme of the new protection program initiated by the Nova Southeastern University Public Safety Department.

In conjunction with the United States Department of Justice and the United States Department of Homeland Security, the Public Safety Department launched a comprehensive **HOMELAND SECURITY TRAINING PROGRAM** for NSU Public Safety staff members. Significant portions of the training program are dedicated to relationships with federal homeland and law enforcement agencies as well as the identification of potential threats on the campus.

All NSU Public Safety managers and supervisors have already completed the instructional program utilizing training materials furnished by the federal government especially for field agencies. Presently, Public Safety Officers are being trained through this insightful and specific training in domestic and foreign generated terrorism threats.

At the successful completion of the training module, each Public Safety staff member will receive a certificate signifying their enhanced professional training. Each PSD staff member completing the course will wear an award pin on their uniform designating that they have been: "**HOMELAND SECURITY TRAINED.**"

The improved protection and service for students and staff members at Nova Southeastern University is the goal and dedication of this new NSU Public Safety program.
