7. Hate Crimes: Those involving crimes of violence against individuals characterized by bias against race, gender, religion, sexual orientation, ethnicity, national origin, and/or disability. Pursuant to the 2008 Clery Act Amendments: "Higher Education Opportunity Act" (Public Law 110-315) hate crime statistics reported under the Clery Act now include larceny-theft, simple assault, intimidation, and vandalism if motivated by bias.
