INFOTRAC DATABASES HELP SHEET

This help sheet will help you search the following InfoTrac databases:

- **General Business File ASAP:** company performance and activity, industry events and trends as well as the latest in management, economics and politics
- **Investext PLUS:** investment, company and industry reports from over **500 brokers** in North America, Europe, Asia/Pacific, Latin America, Africa and the Middle East
- **Expanded Academic ASAP:** meets research needs across **all academic disciplines**
- **Health Reference Center Academic:** Fitness, Pregnancy, Medicine, Nutrition, Diseases, Public Health, Occupational Health and Safety, Alcohol and Drug abuse, HMOs, Prescription Drugs, etc.
- **LegalTrac:** articles in all **major law reviews, law journals, specialty law and bar association journals and legal newspapers**; articles on Federal and State Cases, Laws and Regulations, Legal Practice, and Taxation. Also included are: **British Commonwealth, European Union and International Law.**
