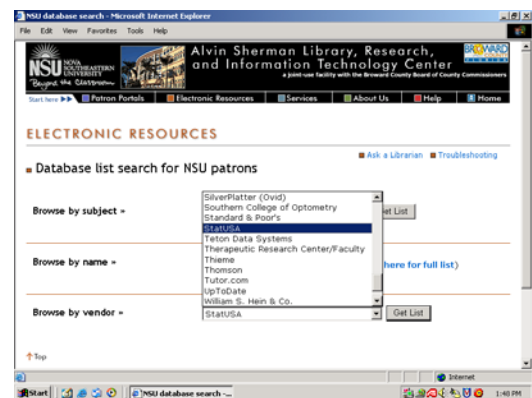

STAT-USA/Internet

The **STAT-USA/Internet** by the U.S. Department of Commerce is the official one stop source to disseminate authoritative information on international trade data, business and economic information from the U.S. Federal Government. **STAT-USA** is a subscription service composed of two major areas: **State of the Nation** and **Globus & NTDB**. It is available from the Alvin Sherman Library at <http://www.nova.edu/library/main/>. To access the database, click on "Electronic Resources", log in with your last name and password and select "Databases".



State of the Nation provides data on the U.S. economy and finance including daily economic news, economic indicators, housing and construction, employment, manufacturing and industry, monetary statistics, and economic policy.

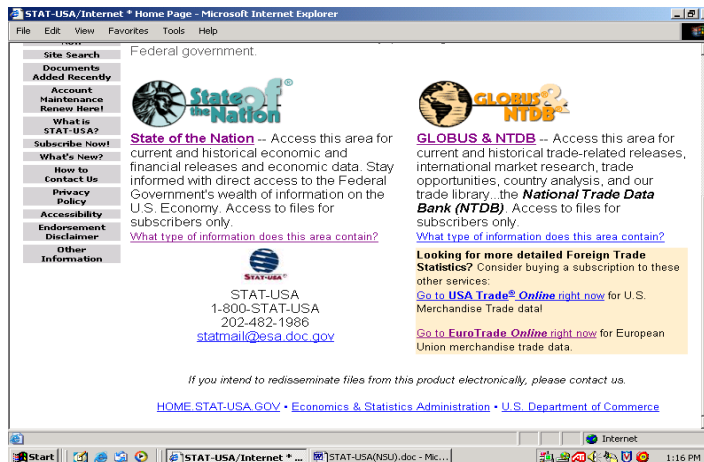

USA Trade Online within **STAT-USA** provides detailed import and export statistics from the Foreign Trade Division of the U.S. Census Bureau. Product categories are available up to the ten-digit Harmonized System commodity code. Data can be viewed for the most recent month available or annual totals for the past three years. You can make use of the search form to find a commodity code, select a level of detail, or browse the hierarchy of commodities. Results can be limited to customs port area and partner country. Reports can be downloaded to an Excel spreadsheet. For a definition of the units that a commodity is measured in, you may consult the *Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the U.S.* at <http://www.usitc.gov/tata/index.htm>



The **GLOBUS** (Global Business Opportunities) has trade leads from the Trade Opportunities Program (TOPS) and procurement activity from the Defense Logistics Agency, United Nations, and Commerce Business Daily Leads. Historical trade leads are available for up to three months. Historical TOPS leads are provided for up to two years.

The **NTDB** (National Trade Data Bank) has Country Commercial Guides, market research reports, and U.S. trade statistics. You can search the entire **NTDB** or just parts of the database. **Country Commercial Guides** are displayed in about 12 sections. The Market Research Reports may include general economic information as well as product and industry reports. **The International Trade library** within the **NTDB** is a comprehensive collection of over 40,000 documents related to international trade. All are full text searchable, as well as keyword searchable by country or product.

At a glance
