NetLibrary

Online collection of full-text books (eBooks) in all subject areas. Current collection includes over 16,000 copyright-protected eBooks along with an additional 3,000 public-domain texts. A database of electronic books (eBooks), the electronic version of print books. NetLibrary provides 24/7 access to over 16,000 and an additional 3,000 public-domain texts. In addition to the standard features of print books, such as indexes, table of contents, and graphics, eBooks have the added value of searching the text for particular words or phrases, and with automatic check-in there is never an overdue fine.

Getting Started

The database's homepage defaults to a basic search using the *Keyword*, *Title*, *Author*, or *Full Text* fields. Clicking on Advanced Search lets you construct more complicated searches using multiple fields (Title, Author, Full Text, Subject, ISBN), Boolean operators and limits (year, publisher, language). The full text field searches for your terms in every word of every eBook. Use this field to search for words that may appear in the text of an eBook but not in the title or other fields. When using this search field, be as specific as possible. You may also use quotation marks to search for full text phrases. For example, you may perform a full text search for "remote authentication" to retrieve all eBooks that contain that exact phrase.

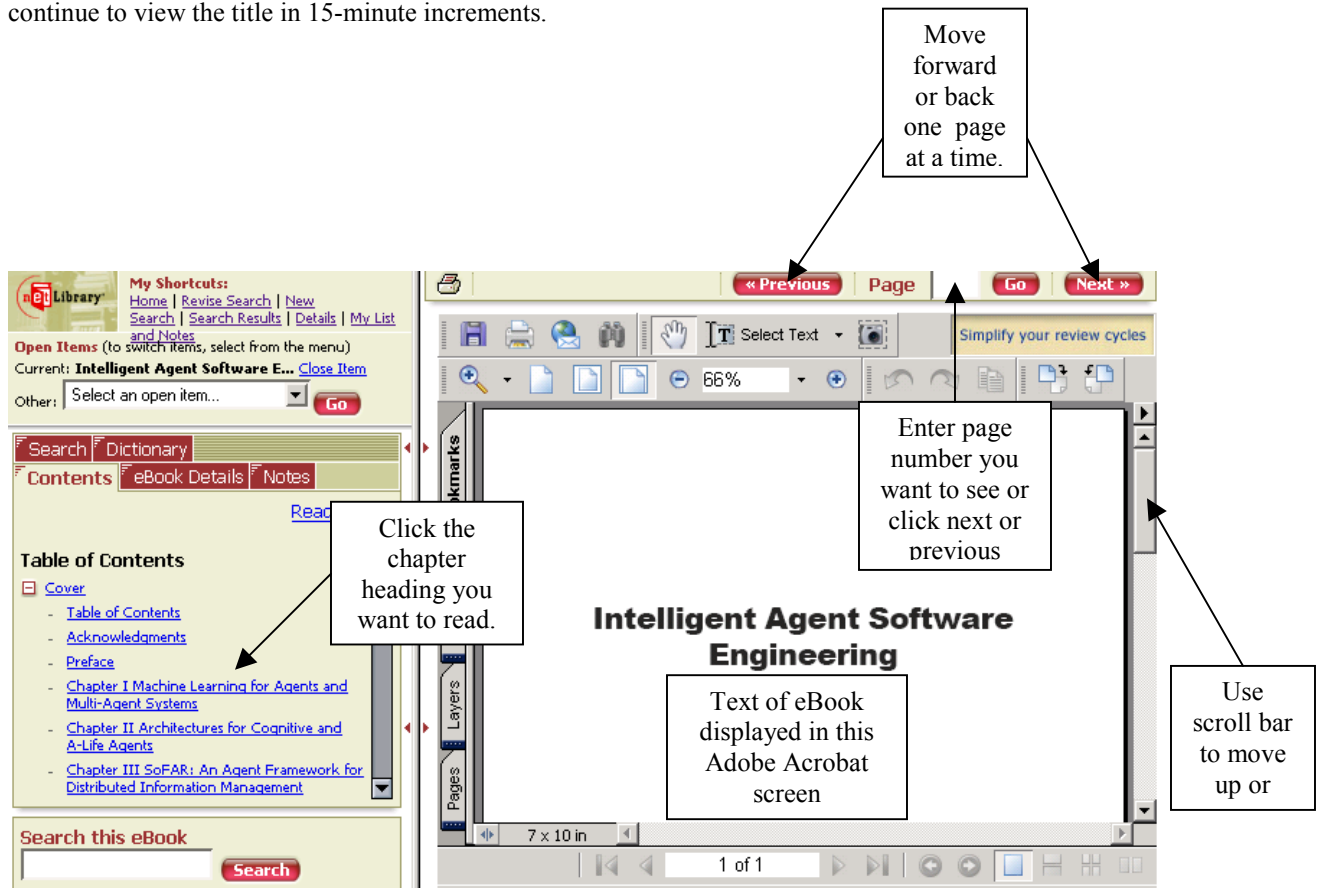

Reading eBooks

The tool palette displays on the left side of the screen when you first open an eBook and the eBook is displayed on the right side. You can expand or contract the tool palette or the eBook by clicking and dragging display frame border. A red message will be displayed at the top of the eBook's screen if it is currently in use by another netLibrary user. You can have the database notify you by email when the eBook becomes available.

View this eBook takes you directly to the online reader to view the full text of an eBook without logging in or creating an account. You may view the eBook for a short period of time (approximately 15 minutes). As long as you are actively using the eBook (turning pages, searching within the full text, etc.) you will be able to continue to view the title in 15-minute increments.



Search: Will find words or phrases (use quotation marks) within the eBook.

Dictionary: Look up any word from a dictionary, thesaurus, Spanish to English or English to Spanish dictionary while reading an eBook

Table of Contents: A red button with an arrow beside the chapter indicates that the heading is expandable when the arrow is clicked.

eBook details: Provides bibliographic information about ebook and link to check out the ebook for 24 hours.

Notes: Allows you to mark a page or add a note to a page for future reference and lists all notes you have added for the title you are currently viewing.

Printing and Copying

Print or copy one page at a time by using your browser's print or copy function. Printing or copying an entire book violates copyright laws. NetLibrary's monitoring software detects suspicious usage patterns that are indicative of excessive printing or copying. The software will log the activity and send you a copyright warning.
