

**Nova Southeastern University
Office of Grants and Contracts
Highlights-FY 2006-2007**

- The university's sponsored funding for research, community service, and teaching/training activities totaled **\$41,516,751** for FY 06-07
- The FY06/07 total represents a **134 % increase** in sponsored funding since FY 99/00.
- The FY06/07 total represents **6.8% increase** in sponsored funding over the previous fiscal year 2005/06.
- Of the FY06/07 total, **59% or \$24,701,301, is to support research.**
- Of the FY06/07 total, **38% or \$15,709,569, is funded by the federal government.**
- Of the FY06/07 total, 45% is funding to the Oceanographic Center, 25% is funding to the Health Professions Division, and 14% is funding to the Mailman Segal Institute for Early Childhood Studies.
- A total of **125 proposals** were processed through the Office of Grants and Contracts during FY06/07, with the largest number, 39, submitted by the Oceanographic Center, followed by the College of Osteopathic Medicine with 22, and the College of Dental Medicine with 17.
- The university is receiving funding from a total of **81** agencies and organizations.
