

**Nova Southeastern University  
Office of Grants and Contracts  
Highlights FY 2009**

- The university's sponsored funding for research, community service, and teaching/training activities totaled **\$47,961,406** for FY 2009
- The FY 2009 total represents **2% increase** in sponsored funding over the previous fiscal year 2008.
- Of the FY 2009 total, **59% or \$28,111,535, is to support research.**
- Of the FY 2009 total, **36% or \$17,276,742, is funded by the federal government.**
- Of the FY 2009 total, 41% is funding to the Oceanographic Center, 19% is funding to the College of Osteopathic Medicine, and 12% is funding to the Mailman Segal Institute for Early Childhood Studies.
- A total of **117 proposals** were processed through the Office of Grants and Contracts during FY 2009, with the largest number, 42, submitted by the Oceanographic Center, followed by the College of Dental Medicine with 14, and the College of Osteopathic Medicine with 12.
- The university is receiving funding from a total of **82** agencies and organizations.
