- Program Description:** Nova Southeastern University's Graduate School of Humanities and Social Sciences houses the Department of Family Therapy. The Department has a M.S. and Ph.D. in Family Therapy (COAMFTE accredited), DMFT (Doctorate in Marriage and Family Therapy), and graduate certificate programs. The master's enrollment is approximately 60 students per year and the doctoral programs enroll approximately 20 students per year. The Department has a large diverse, multicultural student population.
- Qualifications:** Ph.D. in MFT or closely related field; well versed in a postmodern systemic perspective from a theoretical, teaching, therapy, and supervision lens; familiar with COAMFTE standards; licensed or eligible to become a licensed MFT in Florida; AAMFT Clinical Member and Approved Supervisor or AAMFT Supervisory Candidate actively pursuing Approved Supervisor status. Demonstrate research strengths and have background in both qualitative and quantitative methodologies. Demonstrate experience in presentations and publications. Demonstrate experience with multicultural/multinational education.
