

HPD Innovations

HCA Hospital-First phase was completed in 2015

- HCA East Florida built a free-standing Emergency Department on the location of the approved hospital site
 - Hospital will be built around it
 - Hospital completion should occur in approximately two years (2020)



HPD Innovations

Center for Collaborative Research (CCR)

- \$80 million, 215,000 square-foot facility
- September 21, 2016, CCR officially opened
- Research institutes and centers established:
 - AutoNation Institute for Breast and Solid Tumor Cancer Research
 - Cell Therapy Institute
 - Institute for Neuro-Immune Medicine
 - Rumbaugh-Goodwin Institute for Cancer Research
 - Emil Buehler Research Center for Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics

Class Size

- Class sizes range from 3 to 250 students each year, depending on the rules of accreditation for each program.
- Professional programs maintain strict guidelines for class size based on availability of teaching resources.
 - If class size is exceeded the college/program is fined, and jeopardize our accreditation.



The Admissions Process

- Provide applicant support
- Review applications
- Coordinate interview selection (program-specific)
 - Facilitate candidate interviews
- Finalize admission decisions



The Admissions Process

Throughout the application cycle Admissions Counselors and Admissions Service Representatives (ASRs) are:

- Managing applicants' records
- Updating admissions coding in Banner as well as Recruit
- Maintaining statistical data for reporting purposes



Applicant Communication

- On-campus walk-ins
- Scheduled appointments
- Call center inquiries
- Emails
- Virtual chat



Applicant Communications

Applicant counseling involves:

- Provide information on admissions requirements and procedures
- Make recommendations for how to become a competitive applicant
- Provide program-specific information including prerequisites
- Discuss applicant status
- Review transcripts and foreign evaluations



Applying to HPD Programs

Applications may be submitted one of two ways:

- Professional programs
(i.e.: Doctor of Osteopathic Medicine)
 - Two different applications are required:
 - Service Application
 - Nova Southeastern University (NSU) Application
- Online and postdoctoral programs
(i.e.: Master of Health Science)
 - One application is required
 - NSU Application

Service Applications

Application Elements May Include:

- General Biographical and Demographic Information
- Grade Point Averages
- Standardized Test Scores
- Letters of Recommendation
- Personal Statement
- Employment and Health Care Experience
- Observation and Shadowing Hours
- Literature Summary



NSU Application

Documentation that may be required:

Signature Page

- All final, official transcripts
- Standardized test scores
- Letters of recommendation
- Personal essays/statement
- CV/Resume
- Licensure
- Professional articles



Programs Requiring Interviews

Interviews are conducted to determine:

- Personal motivation
- Knowledge and understanding of the profession
- Ability to communicate effectively



Programs Requiring Interviews

Admission counselors determine if a candidate is eligible for an interview based on program criteria.

- Criteria may include:
 - GPA
 - Test scores
 - Health experience
 - Letters of recommendation
 - Preliminary application score
 - Competitive applicants receive notification inviting them to interview.



Interviewing Candidates

- Each program's interview process is unique
- Interview days can range from 45 minutes to a full day and may include:
 - Submission of essay
 - Individual interviews
 - Meeting and/or dining with:
 - Dean and/or program director
 - Students, faculty and staff
 - HPD and/or NSU campus tour
 - Opportunity to participate in Simulation Lab



Admission Decisions

- Files are presented to the Committee on Admissions (COA)
- COA makes admission recommendations
- Office of Admissions processes final decisions
 - Generates letters
 - Updates database coding
 - Acceptance letters are approved and signed by **program dean**
 - Contact applicants to advise status




Completion of the Admission Process

- All requirements listed on acceptance letter must be met, requirements may include
 - Official documents (updated transcripts)
 - Payment of Acceptance/Pre-Registration fees
 - Background/immunizations/physical exam forms
 - Notification of medical insurance requirements
- Orientation
 - Start dates vary by program
