Research, Scholarship, and Creative Activity (75%)

(25%) *Potential for significant and prestigious* contributions to their field of study or other fields/sectors, such as:

- Demonstrates exceptional promise in their field (i.e., future field leader)
- Has a clear research strategy and building a research portfolio
- Early contributions show innovation and exceptional creativity
- Promise for achieving national or international recognition
- Participation in professional development to improve skills/knowledge in an emerging field

(25%) Evidence of early contributions to field through research, scholarly, and/or creative activity, such as:

- Publications in peer-reviewed and/or prestigious journals
- Books published by peer-reviewed and/or top-tier presses
- Presentations at national or international conferences
- Direction of shows or performances
- Acts of service to professional organizations or journals

(25%) Evidence of early recognition in the field, such as:

- Acknowledgement of dean and/or experienced researcher(s) as progressing toward promotion
- Requests by experienced researchers to join team and/or sought after by peers
- Internal and/or external funding record
- Invited lectures or seminars by external entities
- Awards, professional certifications, or other recognitions, especially from outside the university

Teaching, Mentoring, and Collaboration (25%)

(12.5%) Engages with other NSU *faculty or community/external partners* for the purposes of mentoring or collaboration, such as:

- Especially cases where mentorship or collaboration involves faculty outside their department/college
- Working with community organizations or members for collaborative initiatives
- Forming partnerships with industry to secure support and extend scholarly impact

(12.5%) Provides mentoring support to **students** or otherwise engages them with their scholarly activities, such as:

- Connecting their research, creative, and/or scholarly activities with the teaching of students
- Involving students in the conduct of their research, creative, and/or scholarly activities
- Providing guidance and support to students to continue their academic and professional development
