



FINS FOOTBALL SHARK VILLAGE HOST AGREEMENT

The Shark Village Hosting Agreement (the "Agreement") is made between \_\_\_\_\_ (Club/Organization), and the Vice President of Student Affairs.

The Club/Organization will agree to the following:

- The Club/Organization may only host one (1) game.
No more than five (5) students can volunteer to host on behalf of the Club/Organization.
Students who volunteer under their organization will receive a free ticket to the game. Please note that as being a host, you must wait until the tailgate has concluded and all other tailgate patrons have left before you can enter the game.
Club/Organization will be provided with materials to distribute at Shark Village.
Club/Organization acknowledges that up to two additional Clubs/Organizations may also cohost Shark Village for the same game.
Hosts must conduct themselves in accordance with university standards while at Shark Village until hosting responsibilities are finished.
Club/Organization must meet with Dr. Williams, Vice President of Student Affairs and Dean of the College of Undergraduate Studies or a Campus Life and Student Engagement Staff member the Friday before the game to discuss roles and responsibilities and also to obtain any pertinent parking passes, if needed.
Host must pick up materials at a determined time, to be coordinated by the Vice President of Student Affairs Office.

Each Club/Organization will submit their preferences for the game in which they would like to host. Please rank your preferences below from 1 to 7 (1 being your top choice, 7 being your last).
