


SharkLink Student Portal

Introducing the new Shark Link Student Portal. It is a newly designed self-service tool, that will assist our newly enrolled and return students find important information such as account balances, holds and course schedules. The portal is easy to use and centralizes the most important information/services for our students. It also gives students the empowerment to manage and maintain their student account.



Benefits:

- The new portal is intuitive.
- Empowers students by giving them the ability to self-service.
- Simplifies the navigation process of finding information in Shark Link.
- Most important information is streamlined upon login and can be found in one quick snapshot. Students are provided links to be taken to the specific website. For example Self Service Banner, NSU E Bill, Barnes & Noble College etc.

SharkLink Student Portal

The Student Portal has 5 main tabs. (Home, Academics, Finances, Grades & Transcripts and My Profile)

HOME



After logging into the Student Portal, the “Home” tab  will be displayed. Most of the information that students will need is displayed in a quick snapshot on this page.


At the top of the screen is a header that shows the student’s information like Name, ID # and when the password is set to expire.



To display the full ID #, **Click** the eye symbol. 

Students can view their Account Summary and make a payment. After clicking NSU EBill, they will be taken to the E Bill external site where they can process their payments.

The student portal also enables the signed in user to view any holds on their account.



Students can view their financial summary, the status of financial aid applications that were submitted and award decisions for a specific year. These can be viewed under the “My Finances” section by selecting the appropriate tab and selecting the specific year from the drop down.

<p>ONE STOP SHOP</p> <p>The One-Stop Shop is the central point of information and services for walk-in students (prospective, new, and continuing). The staff is cross-trained to answer questions regarding financial aid, registration, billing, transcripts, and parking decals.
