

### ***Assistant United States Attorney Corey Steinberg***

Corey Steinberg has been an Assistant U.S. Attorney for nine years, both in the Southern District of Florida and the Northern District of Georgia. Throughout that time, AUSA Steinberg's primary focus has been the prosecution of Crimes Against Children, including child pornography and child sex trafficking cases. In 2011, AUSA Steinberg secured convictions against George England, a sexual predator who purchased a 6 year old child during the Vietnam war and brought her to the United States where he kept her as a sex slave for decades, the "Boom Boom Room" defendants, who operated a brothel full of minors out of a normal home in a residential neighborhood, and Benjamin Rand, a 20-year old sextortionist. Prior to joining the U.S. Attorney's Office, AUSA Steinberg worked as a compliance officer in the securities industry and as in-house counsel for several large brokerage firms. AUSA Steinberg is a graduate of New York Law School and Union College.
