Purpose: To recognize outstanding student achievement in our undergraduate population.

Policy: Latin Honors are awarded based on students' cumulative GPA once all final grades have been entered after their graduation term. In order to be eligible for these honors, a student must also have 56 graded credit hours of NSU courses. The GPA requirements to graduate with Latin honors are as follows:

1. Cum Laude (3.8-3.89)
2. Magna Cum Laude (3.90-3.96)
3. Summa Cum Laude (3.97-4.0)

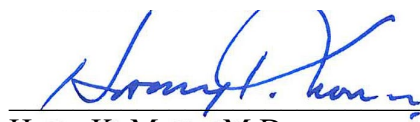
The honors level (Cum laude, Magna cum laude, Summa cum laude) will also be reflected on the student's diploma and official transcript.
