- 2022 Goal to raise \$100K net increase endowment!







ADDED VALUE LEVELS: EXPLAINED

Category Winners Award Pool 85% of entry Pool NSU Scholarship Fund receives 15%.

BILLFISH ADDED VALUE POOL:

Entrants pay \$2,500/Boat

- 60% of Billfish Award POOL awarded to 1st Place by release points
- 40% of Billfish Award POOL awarded to 2ND Place by release points

• FUNFISH ADDED VALUE POOL:

Entrants pay \$1,500/Boat

- 20% of Funfish Award Pool awarded to Highest weight of a single fish caught of each species: DOLPHIN, KINGFISH, WAHOO, TUNA, COBIA
- Note a boat can enter a max of 4 fish per species.
