WI-FI BEST PRACTICES

- > 1NSU is the preferred Wi-Fi that students should use on campus
- The GUEST network is available to non-NSU persons but has reduced speeds
- The 1NSU network requires you to use your username and password to connect. After you change your password, you must "Forget" the 1NSU network and reconnect on your mobile device
