Look out for Seasonal Affective Disorder

Seasonal affective disorder (SAD) is depression you may feel during the same months each year. People who have SAD often get it in the fall and winter.

- Less serotonin. Your body makes the "feel good" hormone when there's lots of sunlight.

- Spend more time outside. Also, let more light into your house by rearranging rooms and changing window coverings.
- Counseling.
