International Student Breakdown










Gender Breakdown of International Students for Fall 2021:

Within the International Student population, there are more Female than Male Students. The breakdown is approximately 60% Female (492 Students) versus 40% Male (330 Students).



The Gender breakdown differs at each different Educational level. Females outnumber Males at every level:



In the Fall of 2021, there were 676 Students Enrolled as Active Students. There were 146 Students that were on Post Completion Optional Practical Training (OPT) during the Fall 2021 Term.


OPT Students are Students who have completed their program at Nova Southeastern University and are legally working for one year in the United States in their field of Study.

There were 207 New International Students (first term at Nova Southeastern) and 615 continuing (or returning) Internationals Students.


New International Students constituted 25% of all International Students, while Continuing Students represented 75% of the total.
