

OTHER FORMS YOU MAY NEED:

**1099-B** SUMMARIZES THE PROCEEDS OF ALL STOCK TRANSACTIONS. ISSUED BY A STOCK BROKER/BARTER.

**1099-DIV** REPORTS DIVIDENDS & OTHER INVESTMENT DISTRIBUTIONS. ISSUED BY BANKS & OTHER FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS.

**1099-G** ISSUED BY FEDERAL/STATE/LOCAL GOVERNMENT FOR PAYMENTS MADE FOR UNEMPLOYMENT, INCOME TAX REFUNDS, CREDITS, ETC.

1099-INT SUMMARIZES INTEREST PAYMENTS FROM US SAVINGS ACCOUNTS, CHECKING ACCOUNTS, AND SAVINGS BONDS. ISSUED BY BANKS & OTHER FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS.

1099-MISC IS SIMILAR TO A W-2, TO REPORT INCOME, FOR INDEPENDENT CONTRACTORS. ISSUED BY INDIVIDUAL/ORGANIZATION WHO MADE PAYMENTS.

1099-R USED TO REPORT DISTRIBUTIONS FROM ANNUITIES, PROFIT-SHARING PLANS, RETIREMENT PLANS, IRAS, INSURANCE CONTRACTS, PENSIONS, ETC.
