## Genocide in the 20th Century and Beyond College of Arts, Humanities and Social Sciences

This course will examine the history of genocide beginning in the 20th century focusing mostly on Europe and Africa: the Holocaust, the Balkans, Rwanda, and Darfur. As part of this study, students will travel to see the first-hand manifestations and implications of genocide. This class is a chance to come to a greater understanding of some of the calamities of the 20th century (and beyond) by not just reading and discussing them, but by visiting the sites where these horrors took place and meeting people who witnessed them and were part of them. Students will write several short papers regarding the readings before they travel and will maintain a journal during the trip recording their reactions to various places. Students will use their experience for a research paper upon their return. (Prerequisite: one HIST course; and COMP 2000, COMP 2010, or COMP 2020)
