To Log in "**NSU**" follow these steps:

- 1. From the Desktop, click on the Network Connections icon in the Windows
- 2. Taskbar (looks like a series of signal bars).



3. Choose "**NSU**" from the list of available wireless networks and click **Connect**.



4. Enter your NSU username and password.

Notes:

- Manufacturer's adapters are often bundled with management software. If you have problems connecting to the "1NSU" 802.1X SSIDs, try disabling this software and use Microsoft's built-in configuration tool instead.
- The first time you connect you might get the message, "Windows can't verify the server's identity (related to the certificate). Click "**Connect**" to accept the server's certificate. After that, authentication will be automatic.
