Incident:

Orlando Police responded to a reported armed robbery at the south parking lot of the Orlando Regional Campus adjacent to the NorthBridge at Millennial Lake Apartment Homes. A male victim with no known NSU affiliation reported to Orlando PD that an assailant with a handgun struck him with the weapon and then robbed him. Orlando PD and NSU Public Safety are investigating this reported crime.

No information on the suspect(s) is available at this time.
