



CRIME ALERT- BURGLARY & MOTOR VEHICLE THEFT

Incident Location: EAST CAMPUS- Vacated Building

Time Occurred: Thursday/8-4-16/approximately 9:00 PM

Incident:

An unknown male was observed by a NSU Public Safety Officer inside a vacated building and a golf cart that was stored inside the building was found to have been tampered with and moved outside. The unknown male fled as the officer approached. Fort Lauderdale police were dispatched but were unable to apprehend the suspect.

The suspect was described as a male with dark complexion wearing a black hooded sweatshirt.

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department and the NSU Public Safety Department are investigating this reported crime.

CRIME PREVENTION:

Members of the campus community are urged to take normal personal safety precautions such as locking their rooms, even when home, walking with a buddy or other known students, walking in well-lit and well-travelled areas and reporting all suspicious persons and activity to NSU Public Safety. If you feel uneasy about a situation, trust your instincts and attempt to interrupt the chain of events. Create a distraction and involve others.
