CRIME ALERT: INFORMATION

*SEXUAL BATTERY at BROWARD COLLEGE CENTRAL CAMPUS

Incident Location: Broward College – Central Campus – 3501 SW Davie Road, Davie, FL 33314, Building 10 - Gymnasium

Date of Occurrence: Wednesday September 12, 2018. Between 10:45 am and 11:30 am.

Incident Details: The Broward College Office of Safety, Security and Emergency Preparedness reported that a sexual battery occurred inside the men's locker room of Building 10 (Broward College Central Campus) on September 12, 2018 between 10:45 AM and 11:30 AM.

*Note: While the incident *did not occur at NSU*, we want to make our campus community aware as it occurred at a nearby institution.

Suspect: The suspect is described as a black male, approximately 19 years of age, short dreadlocks, 5'6" to 5'8", 140lbs, who was wearing purple jogging pants at the time of the incident.

CRIME PREVENTION:

Anyone with information about this crime should call the Davie Police at 954-693-8200.

Members of the campus community are always urged to take personal safety precautions such as locking their rooms (even when at home), walking in groups, walking in well-lit and well- travelled areas, and reporting all suspicious persons and activity to NSU Public Safety. The NSU Public Safety Department provides safety escorts on campus 24/7 and can be reached at 954- 262-8999.

If you feel uneasy about a situation, trust your instincts and attempt to non-violently interrupt events if you feel physically safe to do so. Create a distraction and involve others. Take action to change your circumstances and if necessary your environment. Make a commitment to ensure everyone has a safe way home. Being an active bystander doesn't require you put yourself at risk – if you don't feel safe to intervene, remove yourself from situation and call for help.
