## NSU and the National Student Clearinghouse

**Free proof of enrollment is available to Nova Southeastern University (NSU) students through the National Student Clearinghouse**, which is NSU's authorized agent for issuing enrollment verification through Student Self-Service. It provides up-to-date information on your educational loans and enrollment status, including enrollment dates and full- or part-time status.

You can access the National Student Clearinghouse's Student Self-Service through SharkLink. This program puts the control in your hands, saves you a trip to the One-Stop Shop, and is easy, convenient, and on demand, 24/7.

Self-Service is available to most NSU students and alumni whose accounts are free from existing holds and/or outstanding balances.

## Enrollment and Degree Verification

**It's easy! Obtain a free, official Enrollment Verification Certificate.**

1. Log on to SharkLink at <http://sharklink.nova.edu>.
2. Click on "My Academics."
3. Navigate to the "I WOULD LIKE TO..." section on the right and click on "View Loan Deferments & Enrollment Verification."

This will take you to the National Student Clearinghouse where you may download and print your certificate.

Present your Enrollment Verification Certificate to any insurance agency, housing authority, consumer-product company, bank, lender, or other agency that requires documentation of your enrollment at NSU.

## Degree Verification for the Business Community

Credit grantors, prospective employers, insurance companies, etc., who require degree verification about NSU students and alumni can quickly and easily retrieve this information by visiting [degreeverify.com](http://degreeverify.com).

## Student Loan Deferment and Verification

NSU student enrollment verification for loan deferment is provided to the National Student Clearinghouse monthly. **Clearinghouse automatically updates your status with most lenders.**

If your lender does not utilize Clearinghouse, you can still download your enrollment verification from the Clearinghouse's LoanLocator and forward it to them.

If your lender sends you a deferment form and insists it be completed, sign and mail it directly to

## Look What You Can Do with Clearinghouse's Student Self-Service

- ◆ check enrollment verifications that Clearinghouse has provided to student service providers on your behalf
- ◆ view student loan deferments
- ◆ identify servicers for your private and Federal Family Education Loan (FFEL) student loans
